



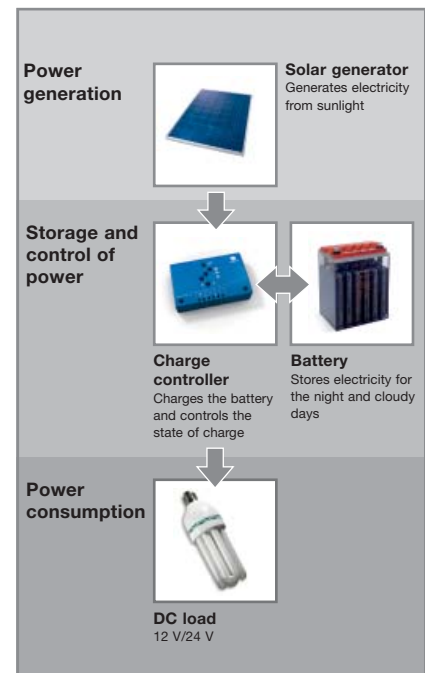

Rural electrification project in Mexico



The district of Ostuacán is located in a remote region of Chiapas in Southern Mexico. About a third of the population has no access to electricity. This project covers households dispersed over a radius of 10km and was financed by the municipal government of Chiapas as a program to improve social living conditions in rural areas. In such an environment Conergy Solar Home Kits were preferred due to ease of use, reliability, low maintenance and long service life.
